DAFFYD-RHYS TIUETI LEAPS OVER THE TRYLINE TO SCORE AGAINST AMPHILL AT THE BPA

As we conclude Block One of the 2025/26 campaign, Coventry Rugby can reflect on a seven-game sequence that showcased our attacking ambition, growing squad depth, and the unmistakable character within this group. While not every result went our way, the performances across the block underline that this side is moving in a very encouraging direction. We began the season on the road at Worcester, where a dominant first half set the tone for our ambitions. The set-piece functioned superbly, our forwards controlled territory, and our physicality put Worcester under real pressure. Although the hosts rallied in the second half, the early performance demonstrated clearly that Coventry can impose ourselves on any side in the competition.

Our home opener against Bedford was a brilliant reminder of the power of Butts Park Arena. In front of a buzzing crowd, the squad delivered a determined, disciplined performance. Even when reduced to 14 men, the boys showed tremendous heart and managed the big moments superbly. It was the kind of win that reflects our identity: together, resilient, and committed. A trip to Chinnor followed, where a blistering start saw Cov race into a 19-0 lead playing some

of our most fluent attacking rugby of the block. Though we were disappointed not to maintain that standard across the full 80, the opening quarter highlighted just how dangerous we can be with tempo and accuracy. The lessons taken forward from this fixture will serve us well. Back home against Ealing, the squad produced passages of outstanding attacking rugby. Peter Sullivan's first-half hat-trick captured the quality we have across the backline, and we consistently caused problems for one of the league's most established sides. While the defensive lapses were frustrating, the ability to score from anywhere on the pitch is a major positive as we push deeper into the season.

The boys responded superbly at Richmond, delivering a ruthless second-half surge to secure a deserved bonus-point win. Our maul was dominant, decision-making was sharp, and the energy within the group was clear for all to see. It was a performance that showed growth and maturity - particularly in how we controlled the closing stages.

A challenging trip to Hartpury came next, and while the slow start proved costly, the reaction after half-time spoke volumes about the character of the squad. Cov scored freely,

controlled territory, and pushed Hartpury right to the final whistle. Although the result slipped away, the fightback was one of the most encouraging aspects of the block.

We closed Block One at home on Community Day against Ampthill, and the squad rose to the occasion magnificently. From the opening whistle, Cov played with ambition, precision, and collective hunger - producing one of our most complete performances to date. Running in a series of well-constructed tries in front of our community partners, supporters, and families made for a brilliant day at the BPA.

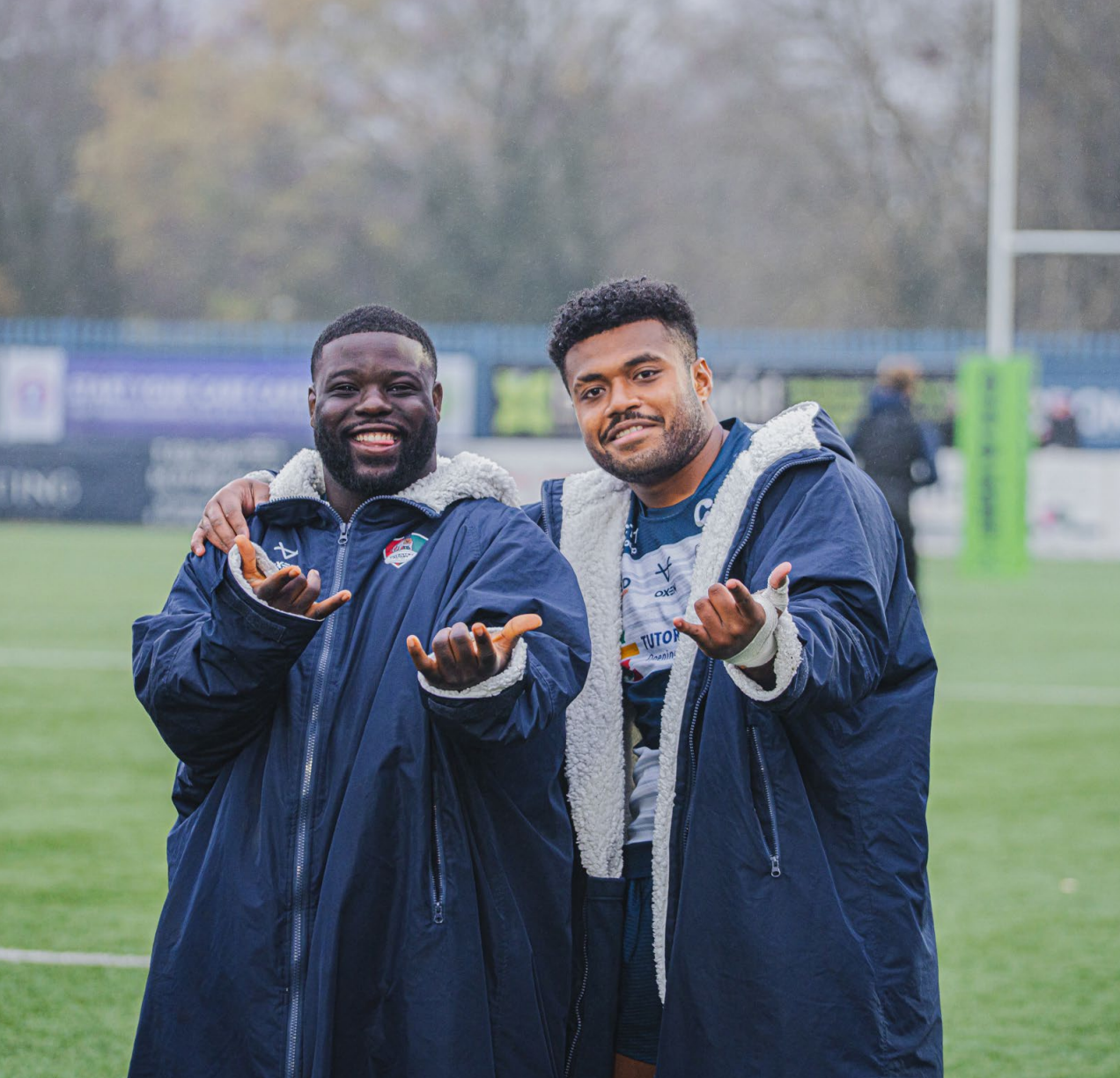

ACADEMY REWIND



Since September, the Coventry Rugby Academy has continued to build meaningful momentum across all areas of our programme. As we move into our U17 and U18 competition blocks, the past few months have strengthened both our on-field preparation and the wider structures that support our pathway.

A major highlight this season has been the growth of our Player Development Programme at U15 and U16. We were proud to welcome over 300 boys to trials—our largest intake to date. This reflects the strength of our widening regional footprint, with established PDP centres in Coventry and The Black Country now complemented by our expansion into Birmingham and Shropshire. These developments have enabled more young players than ever to engage with high-quality coaching and a clear, supportive route into the Academy.

As we look ahead to a demanding fixture calendar featuring Cardiff Blues, RGC, Edinburgh, Glasgow and others, we feel our U18 group is exceptionally well placed for the challenges ahead. It is a talented, committed squad that has prepared with real purpose, and the competitiveness shown throughout training and internal preparation phases gives us confidence that they are ready to attack this block with clarity and ambition.

We were also delighted to see Will Dorrell invited into an England Front 5 development camp. This recognition reflects his work ethic and the shared effort across our coaching and physical development teams to support his progression.

Our Senior Academy continues to develop well, with several players gaining valuable senior minutes each week across National League environments. We are proud to see our athletes running out for Banbury, Newport (Salop), Oxford Quins and Leicester Lions as part of their long-term development, ensuring they are exposed to the physicality, speed and demands of adult rugby.

Our partnerships have progressed significantly too. Our collaboration with The Futures Trust and Three Spires Rugby continues to broaden access and raise standards across the region. We are equally excited about the growth of our Fairfax Academy pathway and look forward to announcing our new South Warwickshire education partner shortly.

The Academy is well positioned as we enter the next phase of the season.
